



## **INGREDIENTS**

## **Crock-Pot Baked Apples**

6 tbsp. butter, softened 1/4 c. chopped pecans 1/4 c. old fashioned oats

1/4 c. brown sugar 1 tsp cinnamon

1/4 tsp. ground ginger Pinch kosher salt 4 apples

For serving Ice cream Caramel, warmed

## **RECIPE PREPARATION**

- In a large bowl, mix butter, pecans, oats, brown sugar, cinnamon, ginger, and salt.
- Slice off top of each apple and use a melon baller to scope out core.
- Stuff mixture into apples, place in slow cooker.
- Cook until apples are tender on high for about 2 hours or on low for about 5 hours. Serve warm with ice cream and caramel.




