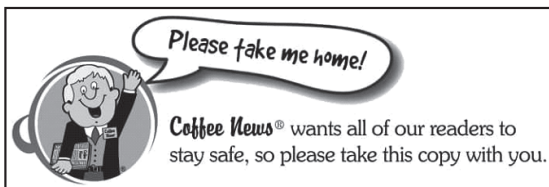



INGREDIENTS
Crock-Pot Apple Butter
6 lb. mixed apples, peeled, cored, sliced
¼ c. packed brown sugar
¼ c. granulated sugar
2 tsp cinnamon
1 tsp vanilla extract
½ tsp ground nutmeg
½ tsp ground cloves
½ tsp kosher salt
¼ tsp ground ginger

RECIPE PREPARATION
• Add all ingredients to crockpot and toss to combine. Cove and cook on low for 10 to 12 hours or until apples and deeply golden and falling apart.
• Using a blender, blend apples until smooth. Pause and remove lid every so often to let steam escape.
• Pour apple butter into jars and cool to room temperature. Cover and store in fridge. Will keep for a few weeks.
