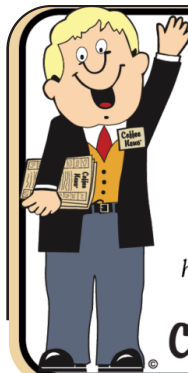
INGREDIENTS

Homemade Apple Cider

- 10 large apples, quartered
- ½ orange, halved
- 4 cinnamon sticks
- 1tsp cloves
- 1 tsp whole allspice
- 1 whole nutmeg
- ½ c. packed brown sugar

RECIPE PREPARATION

- Large stockpot over medium heat, add apples, oranges, spices, and brown sugar. Cover with water by at least 2". Bring to a boil, reduce heat, and simmer covered 2 hours.
- Remove oranges, using a potato masher or wooden spoon, mash apples. Return to a simmer, simmer 1 hour uncovered.
- Strain. Be sure to press on all solids to squeeze all the juice out. Discard solids.
- Serve apple cider warm.
