INGREDIENTS

- 4 apples, such as honeycrisp
- 1/2 c. butter, softened
- 1/4 c. old fashioned oats
- 1/4 c. packed brown sugar 1/4 c. chopped pecans
- 1 tsp ground cinnamon
- 1/4 tsp ground nutmeg
- Pinch kosher salt Ice cream, for serving

RECIPE PREPARATION

- Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Core apples with a mellon baller without cutting through the bottom.
- In a medium bowl mix together butter, oats, brown sugar, pecans, cinnamon, nutmeg, and salt.
- Stuff butter mixture evenly into each apple.
- · Place apples in a small baking dish and cover with aluminum foil. Bake for 30 minutes and then remove foil.
- · Continue baking until apples are tender and insides are syrupy, another 20 minutes. Serve warm with ice cream.


