INGREDIENTS

Homemade Apple Cider 10 large apples, quartered 1/2 orange, halved 4 cinnamon sticks 1tsp cloves 1 tsp whole allspice 1 whole nutmeg 1/2 c. packed brown sugar

RECIPE PREPARATION

· Large stockpot over medium heat, add apples, oranges, spices, and brown sugar. Cover with water by at least 2". Bring to a boil, reduce heat, and simmer covered 2 hours.

· Remove oranges, using a potato masher or wooden spoon, mash apples. Return to a simmer, simmer 1 hour uncovered.

· Strain. Be sure to press on all solids to squeeze all the juice out. Discard solids.

Serve apple cider warm.
