Bad Luck Chuck: Milwaukee, Wisconsin (U.S.), is home of the National Bobblehead Hall of Fame and Museum. It houses a large collection of those little figurines with the oversized heads that bob up and down. The dolls portray a huge variety of figures, such as sports heroes, emojis and characters from movies. One of the newest bobbleheads is "Bad Luck Chuck," a caricature of Charles Penn, who is a super fan of the Kansas City Chiefs football team. He is known to make the team lose if he attends games. Hopefully, those who buy a Bad Luck Chuck bobblehead will keep the figurine at home!

Fast flight: If you were on a certain British Airways flight from New York to London in early February 2020, you would have enjoyed a very quick trip indeed. Flight 112 had the help of a powerful jet stream that created a strong tailwind for the journey. The jet plane reached London in an amazing four hours and 56 minutes. On average, the flight takes six hours and 13 minutes, so passengers arrived at their destination much earlier than expected. The plane reached a speed of over 1,280 kilometers per hour (800 miles per hour) during the flight.

Don't try it: At Pascual Bilboa, a tailoring shop in Bilboa, Spain, customers must pay €15 to try on clothes. Owners Camino Azula Pascual and brother Carlos made the new rule because, with 40 years of experience making custom clothing, they can know people's measurements just by eyeing them. The skilled owners grew tired of people coming into the shop for advice, which could be a two-hour consultation, and then buying clothing somewhere else. They are confident that their skills and their quality clothing will keep customers coming back, despite the controversial fee.

Priceless painting: If you are anything like Vladimir Mkrtychyan of Moscow, you'd better hold on to your childhood artwork. Now a journalist, Mkrtychyan decided to put a painting on the market that he had created when he was just six years old. The surprise selling price is 140 million rubles. The picture portrays a man riding a horse, and the artist claims it reveals Soviet-era realities. Entitled "Red Army Man on Horse," Mkrtychyan found the picture during house cleaning. While not many buyers have come forth, the artist does not intend to lower the price.
