INGREDIENTS My Favorite Egg Salad 12 eggs hard boiled 1/2 cup mayonnaise 1 tsp mustard 1/4 tsp celery seed 1/4 paprika 1/4 tsp kosher salt 1/4 tsp ground black pepper 1/4 cup green onion, diced 1/4 cup cooked bacon, crumbled

RECIPE PREPARATION

1. Ina large pot, arrange eggs in one layer, cover with water.

2. Bring the pot to a boil, cover, and remove from heat. Let stand for 14 minutes.

3. Prepare and ice water bath in a large bowl. Once the eggs are done, transfer them to the ice water bath. Cool for 1 to 2 minutes.

4. Peel the eggs under water, pat dry, then chop.

5. Add chopped eggs to large mixing bowl. Add mayonnaise, mustard, celery seed, paprika, salt, pepper, green onion, and bacon.

6. Serve on a croissant or sandwich bread.
