**Ingredients:**  
1 pkg (2 lbs.) frozen hash browns  
1 can condensed cream of celery soup  
1 can condensed cream of potato soup  
1 8 oz. container sour cream  
1 ½ cups shredded cheddar cheese  
1 small finely chopped onion  
1 green bell pepper, finely chopped

**RECIPE PREPARATION**

1. Preheat oven to 300 degrees
2. Grease a 9 x 13-inch baking pan
3. Spread frozen hash browns into the bottom of the pan
4. Mix the potato soup, celery soup, onion, green bell pepper and sour cream together.
5. Pour mixture over the potatoes
6. Bake at 300 degrees for 30 minutes
7. Remove from oven, sprinkle with cheese and bake another 30 minutes or until cheese melts.
